



Self-assessment exams for the topics of the course

These instructions are applicable to all the self-assessment sheets that we include in each topic, so the self-assessment test of the rest of the topics will contain only one sheet with questions.

- Although in some question there may be several correct answers, there is always one that is the most correct and that is the one that must be marked so that the examination considers it valid.
- At the end of each page the marker tells you the points obtained in the section and the minimum points you would need to pass.
- If you do not get the minimum points for this section, click the delete answers button to try again, but we recommend that you first review the text.
- This is a self-assessment test and, if you wish, you can "cheat", but you will only be cheating yourself.

These exams propose a group of questions of the same type that you will find in the face-to-face exam that you will have to do with your instructor, to give you an idea of what it will be like and help you to lose the possible fear of the exam. You will see that by reading and reviewing the texts carefully, you can pass the exam without any difficulty.

Self-assessment Topic 1

1. The mask must:
